

Completing the 2021 Pennsylvania Public Library Annual Report Using LibPAS Online

The 2021 Pennsylvania Public Library Data Collection (aka Annual Report) is a year-long snapshot of your library or library system that details the resources, finances and services provided to your community. This report, required by the Public Library Code, documents the library's compliance with standards and eligibility for state aid. The data collected is used to inform library stakeholders about library services and finances which can be instrumental in decisions about policy and funding.

Due Date

March 18, 2022 – Each library must complete and submit all required 2021 data on LibPAS for review by the District Library Consultant.

Accessing Data Collection

Pennsylvania Public Library data is collected through the data collection tool, LibPAS. To access LibPAS online use the following link: <https://pa.countingopinions.com/>

Once on the Counting Opinions portal page for LibPAS, click "Login."




Pennsylvania Public Library Data Collection

The Office of Commonwealth Libraries, Bureau of Library Development collects public library data via LibPAS. The data collection tools include the Plans for the Use of State Aid and the Pennsylvania Public Library Data Collection. The statistics gathered are compiled and used to 1) determine public library eligibility for state aid, 2) represent Pennsylvania's public libraries in the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) national data collection program for public libraries, and 3) assist public libraries by providing comparative data for local use.

Login

Enter your Username and Password. If you do not have your login information or if you are a new director and accessing LibPAS for the first time, please send a request for password information to RA-stateaid@pa.gov. **DO NOT CONTACT COUNTING OPINIONS FOR LOG IN INFORMATION.**

It is very important to use this email account (RA-stateaid@pa.gov) for any questions concerning LibPAS or this data collection.



After login, you will be taken to the Pennsylvania “WELCOME” screen, which provides links to “CHANGES FOR 2021”, which includes new data elements and new definitions; “INSTRUCTIONS”; “DOCUMENTS AND FORMS”, which includes signature page, cover sheet, etc.; and step-by-step “VIDEO TUTORIALS”. Note: The “VIDEO TUTORIALS” are not viewable using the **Firefox** browser. After reviewing the WELCOME screen, select “Begin.” You will be automatically directed to the data entry screen for your library.

Navigating the Form

In most cases, after logging in you will be presented with a screen similar to the one below showing the statistical data collection for your library for the reporting period (if not, click “menu,” select “data input,” then set the “Collection” to “Pennsylvania Public Library Data Collection” and check that the “Period” is set to the correct reporting year). **The correct reporting year is 2021.** Before entering data, review the two screen shots below to familiarize yourself with navigation features:

Use this navigation sidebar to navigate to specific section of the report.

The "Review" button lists all questions and responses in one, long, single-page display.

"Print" generates a PDF document that can be saved or printed.

Do not select "Submit/Lock" until all of your data has been entered, checked, and is ready for submission.

To minimize the sidebar and view more of the form in your window, select "Hide". To restore the sidebar, select the ">>" chevron that appears in its place.

The forms site has features to navigate and complete the form. Data is stored as entered, and permanently retained when you click "save."

The Navigation Sidebar allows you to select and work on individual sections. You do not have to complete the sections chronologically, nor do you need to complete individual sections before moving on to other sections. Note: There are empty "check boxes" to the left of most field names. These are entirely for your use and do not affect the completion of the forms. You can use them to keep track of questions you want to return to, or questions you have completed, or you can ignore them entirely.

Select the question links to see detailed definitions, if applicable. To access all definitions select "Prompts" at the top right-hand quadrant of the screen.

You can use the notepad icons to annotate the data. These annotations are meant to provide context to the data entered and will be accessible in the reports.

Use the pull-downs to select from pre-set options.

Data Input

Each User Account has specific access within LibPAS that determines the Collection(s) available for data input. Some of the collections you may see will be Summer Reading, Plan for State Aid, and PA Public Library Data Collection. Each Collection has an associated data input form enabling users to input data for the reporting period. Each of these steps is optional.

Step One:

Select the appropriate Collection form. This step is only necessary when there is more than one Collection form.

Step Two:

Once a Collection form is selected, the user must next select the appropriate reporting Period. In most instances the latest collection period is selected by default. **Note: Be sure the collection period is set to 2021.**

Navigating the Data Input Form

Most Collection Forms are divided into sections. Typically, there are three ways to navigate through the Data Input form.

- Select the name of the section from the list down the left side of the screen. You can “hide” that list by clicking on the “Hide” link. To restore the section navigation box, click the  chevron symbol.
- Use the Next and Previous buttons to proceed through the form, once section at a time.
- Select the Review button. To display the entire form on one web page. This is the same as the initial view when you first load a Data Input form.

You can proceed through each field on the Data Input form by selecting the target field using your mouse, or by using the Tab and/or Enter key to proceed through fields one at a time. To see details for any item in the form, select the question number to reveal more information, such as a definition.

Entering Data

The Data Input forms support many features for ensuring the quality and integrity of the data. Not all entries incorporate these features so you may or may not encounter the following:

- Field length limits - ensuring values contain at least the minimum and no more than the maximum number of characters specified
- Select lists - a limited set of valid values, presented in a pull-down selection for the user’s choice
- Pre-filled values - Data Input fields may already contain data, especially when data for previous Periods is available and the data often does not change from period-to-period
- Previous Period values - typically displayed to the right of the data input field

Correcting Pre-filled Data

Some data has been pre-filled and have been locked, such as the library’s name and telephone number. If there is an error or any change in the pre-filled information, please send a correction to ra-stateaid@pa.gov and our office will make the correction.

Adding Annotations to Explain Data

Using the annotation or notes icon (), explanations can be added for Data values. Explanatory annotations are designed to help reviewers understand and interpret the data and should be used whenever the data is anomalous or abnormal. For instance, when the data represents a significant change from the values previously reported, there is typically one or more reasons. Providing explanations is useful to those responsible for approving or vetting the data submitted and also for those that might later reject or discount the results without a plausible explanation.

Submitting the Report

Submit/Lock Data

Users should use the **Submit/Lock** button to signify when the Data Input process is complete. If a change is required or the user needs to modify its data, contact your district consultant or the state library to unlock the report. If any mandatory data fields were not completed the Submit/Lock function will not operate.

Approving Data (for District Consultants)

After the library has **Locked** its data, the District Consultant will review and **Approve** the data. Once the data is approved, District Consultants can no longer **Unlock** or modify any data for that period. If a change is required, only the State Aid Office can **Unlock** the report to make changes.
